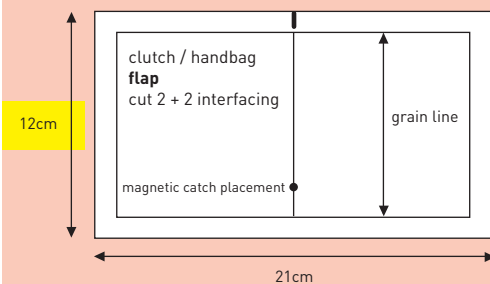
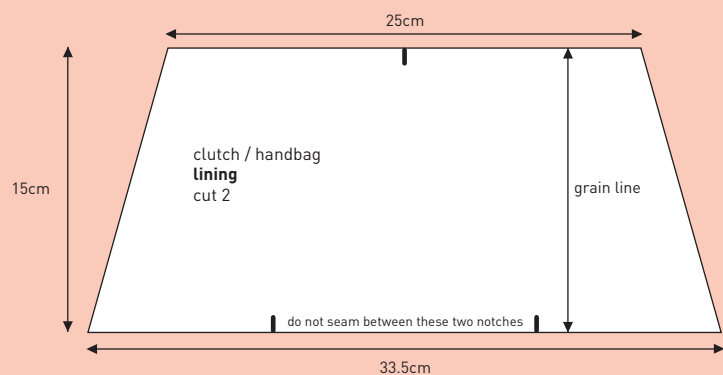
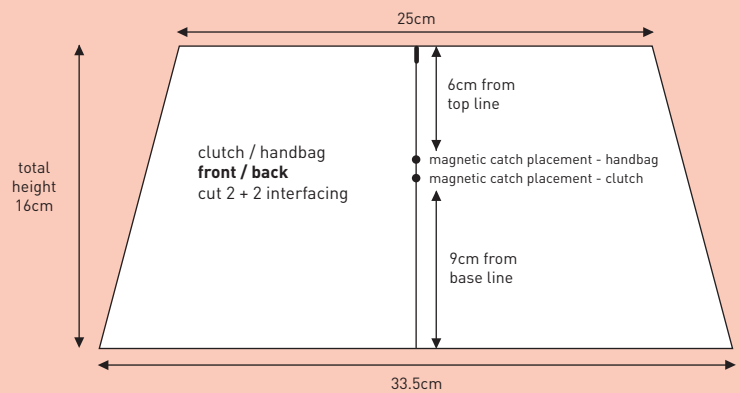
## tip

To give fine fabrics a more structured look, also cut fusible wadding for each front and back piece and for one flap piece. (The side of the flap with the wadding is the outside piece). Fuse the wadding over the top of the interfacing on the wrong side of the fabric.

### cutting

Make paper patterns following measurements on diagrams. Fold fabric in half (selvage to selvage) and pin the front/back and flap patterns in place through both layers of fabric.

**variation:** Cut another layer of sheer fabric for both bag pieces and for one flap piece. Baste over the top of the base fabric (after the base has been interfaced). Cut around the pattern shapes, and clip a small 3mm nick in the fabric at each centre notch point.
